During the summer you will be sent information from several offices within the College. Some of it may necessitate a reply. If you intend being away for any length of time during the summer vacation, please arrange for your post to be forwarded or opened on your behalf.

The College year for first year and 'direct entry' level 2 students commences a week earlier than continuing second and third year students, as it is essential for you to undertake a number of inductions that will allow you to access the College facilities, and orient yourself with the Tremough Campus.

For the start of term, we expect all students to have a 35mm SLR film or digital camera, of reasonable quality, with manual over-ride to any automatic settings. (Nikon is recommended as it is compatible with camera equipment at UCF which you can borrow.)

We also enclose details about the equipment and books that you should have when you start the course.

On Monday 26 September you must bring:

- your camera equipment
- Sekonic Flashmate L – 308B Light Meter

On Friday 30 September you must bring:

- your portfolio, containing recent work
- your sketchbooks, which will form the basis of discussion with your cohort
