

MA Illustration: Authorial Practice

I would like to take this opportunity, formally, to welcome you to MA Illustration: Authorial Practice at Falmouth. I hope that you will enjoy your time at UCF and get a lot out of this programme of study.

The first meeting will take place at **10am on Monday 3 October 2011** in Seminar Room G-H, first floor, Kathmor House at the Woodlane campus.

Both full-time and part-time students will need to be available for the whole of the Induction Week between Monday 3 and Friday 7 October. There will be a number of inductions to various aspects of the course and you will be given a timetable detailing each day's activities.

You will also receive a full introduction to UCF, including campus tours, meet other postgraduate students and be issued with a student handbook. This week sees the first of five Wednesday taught sessions which will comprise an Introduction to Research, and a lecture from 5pm – 6.15pm.

As part of the induction you will be asked briefly to talk about your work, your ambitions for its development and your interests in authorial illustration generally. This will be very informal. You may wish to bring an example of your current practice to show to the group. The intention is to make everyone aware of the various approaches, skills and interests of each individual's practice and to help the group recognise any particular shared areas of interest and to nurture collaboration. Our students come from diverse backgrounds, so this exchange of knowledge and expertise will be valuable to all.

During the summer you will be emailed important information for new students. If you will be away, please ask someone else to check your emails regularly and reply on your behalf. In addition, I will set up a student group email for the new academic year and will send out information to help you when you start the course.
