Please come to your introductory meeting on **Monday 15 September 2014 at 10.00am** in **Studio A** at the **Performance Centre, Penryn Campus**.

During this meeting you will be given an overview of your studies for the coming year, the schedule of classes and workshops for induction week, and other information that you will need to support your work. Most importantly, it will be your first real opportunity to meet everyone and to explore our exciting facilities on the Penryn Campus. We will also begin with some practical work and ask you to come dressed for action in comfortable, loose-fitting clothes.

BA(Hons) Theatre is based in our Performance Centre. The AMATA 2014-15 programme at the Performance Centre includes performances from Belarus Free Theatre, Freefall Dance, Action Hero and 20 Pianos. Tickets for performances are priced between £7 and £15, but limited numbers of heavily discounted voucher packs are available to Falmouth students. We consider seeing high-quality professional work as a vitally important aspect of your experience here, and the voucher pack scheme is intended to make this as affordable as possible.

I'd strongly advise you to try and buy the three year voucher pack, as this will ensure that you are able to see at least 20 shows during the course of your degree. If needs be, you ought to prioritise the voucher pack over books, as we support an excellent library here, and many of the performances we programme would demand vastly higher ticket prices at other venues than that afforded by our scheme.

There are two options for purchasing voucher packs:

- Standard voucher pack - Includes eight Performance Centre ticket vouchers for 2014-15 programme, a Performance Centre t-shirt and a bundle of other vouchers for partner venues. Price £50.
- Deluxe three year voucher pack - Includes 20 Performance Centre ticket vouchers (eight for 2014-15 programme, eight for 2015-16 programme and four for 2016-17 programme) a Performance Centre t-shirt and a bundle of other vouchers for partner venues. Price £100.

All vouchers are non-refundable and are subject to our standard terms and conditions.
