



BURSARY APPLICATION FORM: Under/Over 18 years

Falmouth-Yamaha Jazz Summer School aims to support young players and singers who are in fulltime education and who would value from a concentrated programme of jazz study, and who might find it difficult to fully cover the cost of attending. Bursaries are available for young talented students with playing experience in any style of jazz and improvised music who have a keen interest and commitment to further developing their jazz skills.

There are two types of bursary available for students: **Under 18s** - a full course bursary which is means-tested; **Under & Over 18s** - a partial course bursary which is not means-tested and requires a contribution of £125. Neither of these bursaries covers accommodation, which is £210 for seven nights. Deadline for applications is **1 June 2016**, with notification of a place given by **10 June 2016**.
