

LOANS AND GRANTS

Student Maintenance Loans and Tuition Fee Loans are available to most UK students who are undertaking their first undergraduate degree. Maintenance Grants are also available to those students who can demonstrate that they have a household income of under £42 600pa (for those students paying £9 000 fees).

Students who are eligible to apply can do so online at <u>www.gov.uk/studentfinance</u>. Students who are means-tested and have a low household income may also qualify for a Falmouth bursary. Visit <u>www.falmouth.ac.uk/bursaries</u> for more details.

Payment of loans and grants are made in three instalments which are usually at the start of each term, directly into the student's bank account. Part-time students on undergraduate courses who are in receipt of any means-tested benefit may be eligible to also apply to <u>www.direct.gov.uk</u> for additional support.

Tuition fee loans for UK/EU students are non-means tested. UK students apply online as part of their above loan/grant application and EU students can contact the EU team by emailing: <u>EU_Team@slc.co.uk</u>. All tuition fee loans will be paid directly to Falmouth.
