## What to Expect

### Registration

Visitors will register at the following:

Falmouth Campus: Café Bar  
Penryn Campus: The Stannary Bar

### Information Point

There will be an information point based at the Café Bar (Falmouth Campus) and The Stannary (Penryn Campus), where visitors will be able to collect prospectuses and course leaflets, or obtain information on admissions, accommodation, finance, Student Services and the Students' Union. The information points will be open from 9.30am to 4.00pm.

### Timetable (please see detailed timetable)

Welcome presentations will last approximately half an hour.

Course seminars last for approximately one hour.

Due to limited space entry to some course seminars are restricted to prospective students only. On these occasions, guests are kindly requested to remain in the Café Bar or The Stannary, or are welcome to walk, independently, around the campuses.

### Campus tours

Campus tours will be available at the Penryn Campus throughout the day. As part of your tour you will also have an opportunity to visit the accommodation at the Glasney Student Village at Penryn Campus. Campus Tours at the Falmouth Campus are after your course talk and will incorporate the department as well as the campus.



### Refreshments

The Café Bar at Falmouth Campus and The Stannary at the Penryn Campus, will be open to provide refreshments and food until 4pm. Also based at Penryn Campus are the Performance Centre Café and the Koofi Café based by the Porters Lodge at Glasney Student Village (Penryn Campus).

### Parking at the Falmouth Campus and Penryn Campus

Parking at Falmouth Campus is Pay and Display at the Dell, The National Maritime Museum, or on street parking around the campus. Parking at Penryn Campus is pay and display, and the parking tariffs are set out below on page 7.

### Student ambassadors

Once you arrive at registration our student ambassadors will be looking after you during your visit, taking you on tours and directing you to your course seminars. Please make sure that you ask them lots of questions.

### Walking and Accessibility

Please be aware that you will need to wear appropriate footwear as a certain amount of walking is required. You will need to navigate some very steep hills to reach the buildings at Falmouth Campus. If you have any mobility issues please can you forewarn us so that we can advise you on the programme for the day and make alternative provisions if necessary?

### Free shuttle bus services

Free shuttle buses will be running directly between the Falmouth Campus and Penryn Campuses. These will be in operation continuously between 9.00am and 5.00pm. The shuttle bus will take approximately 15 minutes to travel from the Falmouth Campus to the Penryn Campus. Please allow plenty of time to park and travel on the shuttle bus (if necessary) to the relevant location for registration.

## **FAQ's about the Falmouth Open Day.**

### **Why doesn't my timetable have any room numbers on it?**

During the day you will be guided from the registration points in the Refectory at Falmouth Campus and the Stannary at Penryn Campus. As booking takes place right up to the day we sometimes have to change the rooms at the last minute. In order to ensure that visitors aren't confused by last minute room changes we do not publish the room numbers before the day.

### **Can I change my mind about which course I'd like to attend?**

If you've changed your mind about which seminar you'd like to attend, just come to the relevant course seminar on the day, at the correct time.

### **Can I see extra course seminars?**

We always encourage our visitors to see as much as possible. If you would like to see an extra seminar on the day please make sure that you have the time to fit it in. Let us know at registration on the day, and we can advise you where to go.

### **Can I bring an extra person with me as a guest?**

If you decide to bring an extra person on the day that is absolutely fine, and there is no need to notify us in advance. Please be aware though that if the course is heavily subscribed we may not be able to allow that person into the course seminar. They can accompany you to everything else.

### **Do I need to attend the welcome talk?**

The welcome talks give you an overview of the college and have some important facts and figures. At the end of the welcome talk we separate everyone into the course seminars groups and you are taken straight to the course seminar from here. You only need to attend 1 welcome talk per day.

### **Can I attend an earlier welcome talk and course seminar?**

No, the day is carefully timetabled due to the large number of visitors expected on the day. If you are unable to attend your session at the allotted time please contact the office before the day so we can manage your booking.

### **By Road**

Take the A30 from Exeter or the A38 from Plymouth,  
Join the A30 at Bodmin.

At the Wind Farm, take the A3076 to Truro.

Take the A3076 road to Truro where it joins the A39 to Falmouth.

### **Penryn Campus, Penryn, TR10 9EZ**

At the Treluswell double roundabout continue straight onto the road signposted to the Penryn Campus.

Take the first exit at the Treliiever roundabout (about 9 miles from Truro) and approximately 150 metres further, turn right where signposted into Penryn Campus. Parking at Penryn Campus is pay and display.

The parking tariffs are set out below:

**Monday – Friday (between 8am and 8pm)**

**Up to 2 hours – £1.50**

**Up to 4 hours - £2.00**

**Up to 6 hours - £2.50**

**Over 6 hours up to 12 hours - £3.00**

**Falmouth Campus, Falmouth, TR11 4RH.** At the Treluswell double roundabout take the first exit signposted Penryn services. Continue on the A39 into Falmouth town centre following the sign for the National Maritime Museum. Turn left at the signpost for Falmouth Town train station for the Dell Car Park or continue on for the Maritime Museum car park.

### **By Coach**

National Express Coaches also run daily services to and from Falmouth.

Local bus services run between both Falmouth Campus and Penryn Campuses.

### **By Train**

Rail companies operate regular services to Truro from all major British cities.

The service from London Paddington to Truro normally takes just over four hours.

Change at Truro for branch line services to Falmouth and Penryn.

If you are arriving at London Gatwick airport, it is possible to travel to Falmouth by train via Reading.

### **By Air**

Flights operate between Newquay, Cornwall and London City, Gatwick and Stansted Airports. Newquay Airport is approximately 25 miles from Falmouth and Penryn. The only way you can travel from Newquay Airport to Falmouth is by road. Bus services are infrequent: it would be advisable to telephone Traveline on 0870 608 2 608 or visit [www.traveline.org.uk](http://www.traveline.org.uk) for details of services, times and fares. Taxis must be booked in advance and the fare to Falmouth will probably cost between £45 and £55.

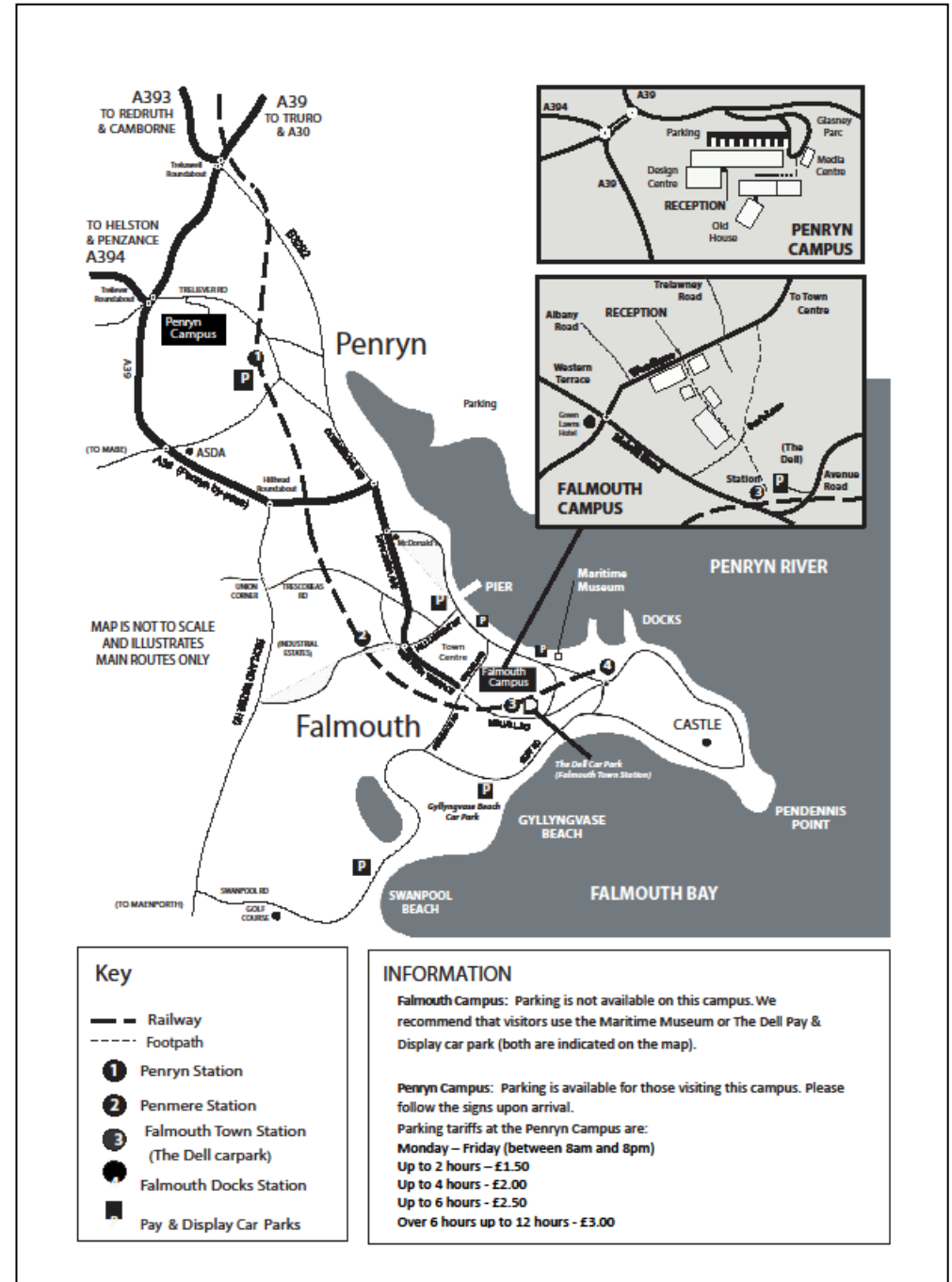
