

As we look forward to celebrating with you at your ceremony next month please take some time to read the information regarding graduation below.

We are expecting a record high number of people on campus for graduation this year, so please be mindful of this when planning your journey onto campus.

Car parking

There are over 2,000 car park spaces on campus. Parking is free for the duration of graduation.

We have shuttle buses moving around campus from the car parks to registration

Golf buggies are available throughout the campus for those that have difficulty walking.

Registration

You will collect all your tickets on arrival at the registration desk. You need to bring your student ID or other Photo ID. Please remember tickets are only valid for the Ceremony Hall, you are welcome to bring all guests to campus and the pre and post-ceremony Receptions.

Robing

Robing is in the Exchange, adjacent to Registration. Please note that you must wear robes to attend your graduation ceremony. Sadly we cannot let anyone attend their graduation ceremony without the official robing.

Photography

Portrait photography is also in the Exchange. There is the opportunity to buy photographs of your hand shake with Dawn and the department group photograph in the Italian gardens, after your ceremony. To avoid long queues we advise you to have your portrait photographs taken after your ceremony.

Pre ceremony

Pre-ceremony takes place at the bottom of The Exchange. We have two magic Mirror photo booths for some fun photos, street food vans, and a carousel for your enjoyment. Announcements will be made advising when the ceremony doors open and are closing.

Ceremony

Doors open one hour before your ceremony starts.

Graduation

Please leave all your belongings, including your mobile, with your parents.

The doors close fifteen minutes before the ceremony starts. Anyone arriving after this time will not be allowed to enter the hall.

Parents are seated separately from the graduands. You will be able to meet up with them after the ceremony and department photograph, in the Italian gardens.

There will be British Sign Language Interpreters in some ceremonies.

Please notify us in advance of any disabilities, if you haven't already, so that we can make your day as special as possible.

If you leave the hall during the ceremony, you may not be allowed to re-enter straight away, until an appropriate moment between speeches.

We have zero tolerance for bad behaviour, and you will be removed by security if you behaviour is deemed inappropriate.

Live Streaming

If you are unable to attend the ceremony in the hall, or do not wish to watch from the hall we have two venues on campus where you will be able to watch the ceremonies live. Staff will direct you to those venues on the day

Post Ceremony

Straight after the ceremony you will be taken as a group for the department photograph with senior academics and the Chancellor, Dawn French, in front of Tremough House. After this you are free to join your friends and family in the Italian Gardens to celebrate.

Food & drinks

There will be a variety of food and drinks available to purchase across the campus. Fresh pasties and cream teas are being bakes on site, and there is a secret gin garden to find. Street food vans offer tempting nibbles, and there are bars open across the campus.

Dogs on campus

Please do not bring your dog to graduation, unless it is an assistance dog. You will be asked to remove the dog from the event if you do.

University Merchandise

There will be university merchandise available for you to purchase.

You are welcome to bring additional family to celebrate your day with you. We cannot guarantee that they will be able to enter the ceremony hall to watch, but they will be able to enjoy the rest of the day with you on campus.
