First week of term

We are delighted that you are joining us in September. The academic year commences on **Monday 14 September 2015**. Please join us outside the **main Reception, Penryn Campus** at **9.30am** where a member of the team will be there to meet you.

At the start of term you will be introduced to your first project so it is essential that you bring your own camera equipment. You will require:

- DSLR camera with standard 50mm prime lens, capable of shooting in RAW format with settings allowing for fully manual operation (Canon & Nikon are supported by our photographic stores)
- A 4Gb (minimum) high speed memory card is recommended for the above together with a USB card reader
- Sekonic Flashmate L-308S light meter (or similar)
- USB flash memory stick (minimum 4Gb recommended)
- USB portable external hard drive (minimum 250Gb recommended)
- Blower brush or sensor cleaning kit and lens cloth

During the first week you will have the opportunity to participate in a number of activities including a study trip to St Ives or a surfing lesson. If you would like to surf, the lesson will cost around £30 per student, which includes hire of boards and wetsuits. Places will be limited but we will give you all the information you need at the start of term.

There will be a study trip to London during London Fashion Week in February 2016 that we hope all students can attend. The estimated cost will be around £250. The cost will be broken into smaller payments, however, a deposit of approximate £50 will be required in the first term.
