You'll begin your course on **Monday 18 September 2017**. Please report to **Studio B, Performance Centre, Penryn Campus** at **12 noon** for a welcome talk.

Highlights of the forthcoming AMATA 2017/2018 programme will include Budapest Cafe Orchestra, Tavaziva Dance, and Omar Sosa and Seckou Keita. Our full Autumn Season programme will be available at http://amata.org.uk/ from 18 August.

Individual tickets for professional performances can cost up to £20, but Falmouth University students can purchase season tickets and save up to 70% on the face value of tickets across the AMATA Public Programme, as well as avoiding booking fees. There are two options for purchasing AMATA Student Season tickets:

A one-year student season ticket contains six tickets for performances and events at AMATA in 2017/18 and costs £50. A three-year student season ticket contains 18 tickets (six tickets per year for the 2017/18, 2018/19 and 2019/20 programmes) and costs £100. Both Season Ticket deals include an AMATA t-shirt.

We strongly encourage students to purchase season tickets as they provide a highly subsidised, cost-effective way of attending performances and events that have been programmed to enhance and support your studies at AMATA. Season tickets are available now to book at amata.org.uk/seasontickets

Study trips and costs

Study trips, placements and assessed events are an inherent part of BA(Hons) Music, Theatre & Entertainment Management. We will cover transport costs for essential study trips, but from time to time other opportunities may arise which may require you to contribute to the cost.

Placements can be undertaken on, or near to, campus at limited cost. However, in the past, students have opted to travel as far afield as Norway and Los Angeles to undertake placements that they have organised and funded themselves. In some instances we will support group placement opportunities and transport costs. We will provide a small budget contribution towards assessed projects and events, so that each student group has funding in place. Optionally, you may wish to add to your budget through fundraising, ticketing and so on.

Enrolment and Student Terms & Conditions

You'll get an email two weeks before the start of term telling you how to enrol online. You'll need to enrol before the first day of term to officially register as a student of Falmouth University and receive an undergraduate student loan.

When you enrol, you'll need to agree to and comply with the University's Student Terms & Conditions. These Terms & Conditions are important and we encourage you to read them carefully, before enrolling. You can find them under 'Student Terms & Conditions' on our website.
