

### Transport Information

#### By road

Take the A30 from Exeter or the A38 from Plymouth, which joins the A30 at Bodmin. Continue along the A30 and, at the wind farm, watch out for the signpost for the A3076 to Truro. Take this road to Truro where it joins the A39 to Falmouth.

For the Penryn Campus, take the first exit at the Treliever roundabout (about 9 miles from Truro) and approximately 150 metres further, turn right where signposted into the campus. Penryn Campus has a pay and display car park.

National Express Coaches also run daily services to Falmouth. Local bus services run between both campuses.

#### By train

Rail companies operate regular services to Truro from all major British cities. The service from London Paddington to Truro normally takes just over four hours. Change at Truro for branch line services to Falmouth and Penryn. From Truro, the journey times are approximately 15 minutes to Penryn.

**Opening Times** – During term time The Photography Centre Stores open from 9am – 9pm seven days a week. The hours are reduced during the holiday periods; operating Monday to Friday daytime only (with breaks during the day).

**Car Parking** – An Automated Number Plate Recognition Barrier System is used on the Penryn Campus. Before returning to your vehicle to exit the car park you will need to visit a Pay Station, enter your vehicle registration and follow the touch screen instructions to pay the appropriate tariff. Pay Stations accept coins as well as credit and debit cards. Then on leaving the Campus, and as long as the appropriate tariff has been paid, the barriers will rise automatically on exit. The exit points have also been fitted with an intercom which is operational 24/7 should you require support at the barriers for any reason. Parking charges are as follows -

#### Monday – Friday (between 8am and 6pm)

Up to 1 hour – FREE  
1-2 hours - £1.90  
2-4 hours - £2.40  
4-10 hours - £3.40

#### Monday - Friday (between 6pm and 8am)

Free but barriers still in operation.

#### Weekends (Friday 6pm – Monday 8am)

Free but barriers still in operation.

There is a small loading area adjacent to the Photography Centre Stores available to all users of the Centre but this is strictly limited to a 30 minute stay.

Visitor's parking spaces can be reserved adjacent to the main campus reception but these are still subject to the standard parking charges and availability. Please contact the Photography Stores at least 48 hour beforehand to arrange reservations.

**Wi-Fi** –The Photography Centre has Wi-Fi facilities throughout the whole building. Please contact the Photography Stores in advance should you require these services so that we can arrange a user name and password.

**Food and Drink** - Penryn Campus has five different catering establishments which operate from breakfast through to evening meals, offering a wide range of freshly cooked dishes, salad boxes, paninis, snacks, pizzas and hot and cold beverages. There is also an on-site shop which sells everything from arts supplies and groceries to a wide selection of snacks.
