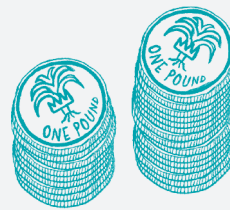


We are offering new EU Funding Bursaries which we hope will encourage applications from people who might not have previously considered studying with us in the UK.

In order to be considered for this bursary you will need to have been 'income assessed' by Student Finance England. Please apply promptly to Student Finance England www.gov.uk/apply-for-student-finance. EU funding for 2015-16 opens in March.

Income Assessed Bursaries

New EU students commencing an undergraduate course starting from 2015 who are assessed by Student Finance England as having a household income of under £35,000 a year will automatically receive an 'Income Assessed Bursary' from Falmouth University. The level of award will vary dependent upon your exact level of household income and the anticipated additional course costs you may face. This will be awarded each year, assuming that your financial circumstances do not change.

How it Works



Step one

Apply for Tuition Fee Loan

www.gov.uk/apply-for-student-finance

Step two

You will then receive a letter from Student Finance England asking if you wish to be 'income assessed'. You must complete the assessment process, returning the paperwork requested.

Step three

If your level of household income is assessed by Student Finance England to be under £35,000 a year you will receive the appropriate bursary upon enrolling on a Falmouth University undergraduate programme for at least one full academic year commencing from 2015.

Please note applications for EU funding open in March.
