- Three coach loads of students attended the National Demo against the rise in tuition fees
- First female president for the University of Exeter is elected (Kristy Wallace)
- Six Executive Officer Positions are created
- 36.4% of students voted in the Presidential Elections
- 2 new members of staff are introduced as Sports & Recreation Assistant
- The FXU had 45 Clubs and Societies
- Rally for Haiti raised over £4000
