**Summary of the Awards**

Falmouth University is offering a number of scholarships for 2018/19 undergraduate applicants. These include the **International Talent Scholarship**, the **International Student Scholarship – India and Malaysia** and the **Across the Pond Scholarship**.

Applicants must qualify as an International student (due to pay International fees) and be a new student to Falmouth University in academic year 2019/20. Only students intending to study at Falmouth will be considered. Applicants for DIME, Bodmin College, Flexible Falmouth, ACM or FRA should contact their course provider directly.

In order to be considered for an award, you will need to have a live course application with Falmouth University, on the scholarship closing date (26 April 2019).

**Eligibility**

All applicants must:

- Qualify for the International tuition fee rate
- Be a new applicant to Falmouth University in 2018/19
- Be applying to an undergraduate course which is Falmouth based (not a through a partnership organisation)

### Application process

- Applicants must complete the 2019 international Scholarship form here: <https://app.geckoform.com/public/#/modern/FOEU025aSixcIRVL>
- Applicants for the **International Talent Scholarship** and **International Student Scholarship – India and Malaysia** only need complete the application form once in order to be considered for all awards for which they may qualify.
- No application needed for the Across the Pond Scholarship. All qualifying students to be automatically considered.
- The Student Funding Team will inform applicants of outcomes after the **1<sup>st</sup> June 2019**. All applicants will be contacted by email, as per the address provided in their application.

### Supporting statements

The application form will ask applicants to provide two short supporting statements, which give reasons as to why they should be considered for a scholarship. These will cover:

1. The contribution the applicant will make to the course and to the wider Falmouth community. This should include details about skills, background and experience.
2. Details of any financial needs the applicant may have.

### To note

- Only those applicants with a live course application, with Falmouth University, on the 26 April 2019, will be considered for a scholarship. This will be checked by The Student Funding Team and no evidence is needed from the applicant.
- Applications will be considered by both the Student Funding Team and representatives of academic departments. Decisions will be based on both the quality of the scholarship application and the recommendation of Admissions tutors.
- Decisions of the panel are final.
- Applicants cannot receive more than one scholarship
- EU students and those applying for postgraduate studies are not eligible to apply.
- Successful applicants, who then choose to defer to 2020, may lose their offer of an award. This is at the discretion of the Student Funding Manager and International Sales Team.
