

FALMOUTH-YAMAHA JAZZ SUMMER SCHOOL 2016 TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The booking of a place on the Jazz Summer School from 15-20 August 2016 is regarded as acceptance of our terms and conditions.

The Falmouth-Yamaha Jazz Summer School is open to all nationalities, aged 14 and over. An *in loco parentis* form will need to be completed and signed by the parent or Guardian of all under 18 year olds. Falmouth University will provide a Pastoral Care Monitor throughout the duration of the Summer School.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Cancellation fees will apply as follows:

- Up to 8 weeks prior to the start of the Summer School – full refund minus £50 administration fee
- Between 8 and 4 weeks - 25% of total charge plus £50 administration fee
- Between 4 and 3 weeks - 50% of total charge plus £50 administration fee
- Less than 3 weeks prior to the start date – No refund

No refund will be made for non-attendance.

CODE OF CONDUCT

To ensure that everyone taking part in the Summer School has a rewarding and enjoyable time, we ask you to agree to and abide by the following code of conduct. The breach of any rule stated below may result in the cancellation of place on the Summer School.

- The Falmouth-Yamaha Jazz Summer School takes place in the Academy of Music and Theatre Arts (AMATA). You will be expected to adhere to AMATA's Health & Safety regulations and to follow any emergency procedure, such as a fire drill, as directed by the Summer School staff and tutors. A full risk assessment has been carried out and is available upon request.
- Any damage to property, equipment and rooms will be charged to the participant.
- The Summer School works through mutual respect. Inappropriate or intimidating behaviour towards another participant or member of staff will result in cancellation of place on the summer school.
- Consumption or possession of alcohol by anyone under the age of 18 is not permitted and could result in cancellation of place on the summer school.
- Drug taking or possession of drugs will result in cancellation of place on the summer school and potential police action.
- There will be separate male/female sleeping and bathroom accommodation for under 18s, and a curfew will be applied.

We reserve the right, unless we are advised to the contrary by the parent/guardian in writing, to use these photographs or video clips as part of future Falmouth-Yamaha Jazz Summer School promotional material.
