### **Presentations, Advice and Guidance**

We offer presentations to cover a range of topics and these can be tailored for students at all levels, as well as for parents. Presentations can be about:

#### ► **Creative Careers and Progression**

This session seeks to challenge some of the stereotypical thinking around creative careers and raise the aspirations of students studying visual arts, business, technology and performing arts subjects.

#### ► **Personal Statement and Applications**

A masterclass in writing your personal statement and approaching the UCAS application process.

#### ► **Portfolio Advice**

Guidance on what to include in a creative portfolio and how to present it.

#### ► **Student Finance**

An introduction to student finance and how it works.

#### ► **Falmouth University or a specific course area**

This presentation covers university life at Falmouth, courses on offer and what it's like to study at a creative institution.

### **Higher Education, Careers and Options Events**

Our partnerships team are all experienced educators and advisors who will support your careers and progression event with an information stand, manned by themselves or one of our trained student ambassadors.

### **Guest Lectures and Masterclasses**

Our academic team are often able to come into your school or college to deliver a masterclass or guest lecture. This can include course specific talks, advice sessions or subject masterclasses across the full spectrum of creative arts, digital and technology, business and performing arts subject areas.

### **Travel Bursaries and Regional Interviews**

We recognize that it isn't always easy for students to come and visit us for an Open Day or for their interview. Financial support can be arranged for individuals who have difficulty in attending Open Days and/or interviews; please discuss this with your regional representative. Students may also be invited to attend an interview or audition at a regional venue, closer to their place of residence.

### **Campus Visits**

Schools and colleges have the opportunity to visit our campuses at Penryn and Falmouth for an introduction to university life. Visits can include tours, workshop sessions across a range of disciplines including visual arts, business, technology and performing arts.

### **Overnight Accommodation**

Schools and colleges travelling from further afield may wish to take advantage of overnight accommodation as part of their campus trip. Your regional partnerships representative can discuss financial support for travel and accommodation with you.
