Introducing colour into your documents

- Understand the difference between colour modes
- Discover the difference between strokes and fills
- Create and save new colour and gradient swatches
- Mange colours in the swatches panel
- Apply colour to your document using a variety of tools

Working with long documents

- Create and apply character and paragraph styles
- Work with master pages to ensure consistency
- Use Indesign layers to organise elements
- Create and format various tables

Working with shapes and objects

- Draw and edit basic shapes
- Group, ungroup and name a group of objects
- Use the Pathfinder panel to manipulate shapes
- Use the Pen tool to create various shapes
- Add different effects to objects
- Create and save object styles

Interactivity in Indesign

- Export and publish interactive documents
- Add Animation to your document
- Export or publish your animation online

Save, export and output your documents

- Preflight your document to check for errors
- Back save your documents
- Archive your work the packaging process
- Export your Indesign documents in various formats
