

Short Course to Master's Pathway Award for Falmouth University master's level programmes

In recognition of the commitment to creative learning in your chosen field, Falmouth University is offering a £1,200 tuition-fee discount to applicants who have completed an eligible 'pathway' short course relevant to their linked master's degree.

1. The offer

- £1,200 discount from the full tuition-fees for eligible linked master's degrees starting in January 2026, May 2026, September 2026, January 2027 or May 2027. Students will receive their discount either from the full price if paying in full, or from the final course fee if paying in instalments.
- This offer is for new students enrolling onto an eligible master's degree (on-campus or online) in 2026 who have completed an eligible short course with Falmouth University since September 2024.

2. Allocation and payment of the discount

- Student must notify their Course Advisor that they wish to apply for the Short Course to Master's Pathway Award when making their application **in a separate email**.
- Upon application, students must note that they have completed the short course. Eligibility will be established through Falmouth University's Academy of Continued Education. Their decision is final.
- The discount will be withdrawn for those students who withdraw from their course part way through the year. As such, they will be liable to pay the full rate of fees for the period attended, as per the Falmouth University Fees Policy.
- Students who intermit from their course part way through the year will continue to qualify for the discount upon the resumption of their studies. If an intermitting student instead chooses to withdraw from their course, then the above point will be applied retrospectively.

3. Applicant criteria

- Applicants must have completed an eligible 'pathway' short course at Falmouth University that is directly linked to their master's degree. Eligible short course to master's pathway courses will be listed on the Short Course to Master's Pathway Award webpage.
- Applicants must have completed an eligible short course at Falmouth University since September 2024. Students who partially completed and / or received a refund for withdrawing are not eligible.
- Students must enrol onto the linked master's degree at Falmouth University, this offer only applies to master's degrees directly linked to the eligible short course. If applicants wish to apply for a master's not linked to their course, then they may still be eligible for the general short course to master's award. [Details here](#).
- Applicants must be a new student at Falmouth University commencing their studies in 2026 which includes starting in January 2026, May 2026, September 2026, January 2027 or May 2027.
- Be entering directly into study block 1 in the first year of the course.
- Applications who defer to September 2027 and after will not be considered.

4. Limits to offer

- This discount cannot be used in conjunction with any other discount at Falmouth University including, but not limited to: Early Bird Discount, Graduate Loyalty Discount and Refer a Friend Discount.
- This discount only applies to eligible linked master's degree programmes.
- The discount cannot be applied for after a student has enrolled on their course.
- Falmouth University reserves the right to change or withdraw this offer at any point and without prior notification.
